Water and Sewer Connection Fees

Water and Sewer Connection Fees are separate and are due before the connection can be scheduled.

Connection fees account for the cost associated with physically connecting into an existing, permitted water main or force main to extend service to a residential development or installing a water or sewer service connection for a commercial development, including any required shutdown coordination efforts.

Wet Taps - A licensed utility contractor must prepare the main line and coordinate with BJWSA who will perform the actual tap to the main.

Shutdowns - When a wet tap is not possible or the relocation of a water or sewer line requires interruption of service, BJWSA will identify those customers affected by the shut down and schedule notification to the service interruption.

If a pre-construction meeting is required for the project, the pre-con must be held before a quote can be released.

10" and smaller	\$400.00
12" and larger	\$1,300.00
